



Stefano Saglia

Since August 2018, he has been a Board Member of ARERA - the Italian Regulatory Authority for Energy, Networks and Environment.

He has always had a particular interest in economics and the relationship between productive activities, education and social issues.

From 2009 to 2011 he was Undersecretary of State at the Ministry of Economic Development, with responsibilities for matters falling within the Remit of the Energy Department, as well as for matters relating to the market, competition, consumers, supervision and technical regulations. Mr Saglia was also a delegate to the Presidency of the CNCU, the National Council of Consumers and Users.

In 2001 he was elected to the Chamber of Deputies for the first time and re-elected in 2006 and 2008, remaining in office until 2013.

In the XV Legislature he was Vice President of the X Economic Activities, Trade and Tourism Committee of the Chamber of Deputies. From 1995 to 2000, he was an executive at the President's Office of the Lombardy Regional Council. In 1995, at only 24 years of age, he joined the Brescia Provincial Council, and from 1999 to 2001 he was Vice President and then became Councillor for Employment and Productive Activities.

In 2010 he received the 'Man of the Year' award for energy from the newspaper *Staffetta Quotidiana*, the *Rivista Italiana del Petrolio* and the *Fondazione Energia*.
